

Na Denmark, Community Report February 2010

Denmark has five areas and we have 142 meetings all over the country. In the Copenhagen area we have 53 meetings every week, two of them are English Speaking Meetings.

All areas are participating the RSC and no RSC service positions are vacant.

The Translation Committee has got new members and is working hard to get more literature out. Right now they are translating parts of the CAR and every member of NA Denmark is waiting for the proved edition of Just For Today.

PI are busy too; The Recovery March was a little success and there will be another one this year. At The Skanderborg Music Festival PI also worked hard to carry the message.

Danish NA members are also participating in Swedish meeting regarding **ECCNA 2011** and Sweden sent delegates to inform us at our RSC meeting in November.

At the RSC meeting November 2009 we had a big problem: Many and too expensive visions! Every committee had to cut their budget, but we succeeded doing the cutting in a loving and respectful atmosphere. Our income mainly relies on donations from the areas, but we try to raise money the best we can and we still make no profit on literature selling! The proved budget for 2010 is now 132.000 Danish Kroner which is roughly 40.000 Dkr. more than 2009. Donations to World Service and EDM will follow.

I have been in touch with the chair of **RSC NA Iceland**, Elin, we have met and mailed a lot. Lately Iceland have asked Denmark to be their sponsor ☺ We will discuss the request at our Service Conference in April, but until now I have only received very positive responses to the request. Iver and I will do our very best to assist Iceland till the sponsorship is settled!
