The spine get loose, the pages fall apart, as you can see on the pictures attached (it's my own copy, and that happen after only a month). And asking around many members tell me that the same happen to theirs.

You (or Ushi) tells us "we need to observe publication standards as a publishing house, which is what we are", this is not an acceptable standard for a publishing house. If I had bought this book at a bookstore, I wouldn't hesitate to go to the store and ask for a new copy, but I know this is a little difficult in this case. But the least we can expect is that you make better work when the next portion is going to be printed. And thinking of "It works" which I hope you are about to print very soon, I hope you make that in hard cover, and make a professional job with that!

You may correct me if I'm wrong - but I assume that you only have made one edition of this JFT - meaning that all the books that are at stock at WSO, in Brussels and the one we have in Denmark, were printed and produced last summer, and that you haven't made second printing? Or?

If that's so - the simple answer to your question on how many defective there is - will be "all of them". I had 4 books in my hand the other day, they were in my home group and have just been lying there to sell, as soon as I open them, they fall apart. And of course the book lying in boxes WSO-Europe looks fine as long as they lay there but as soon as you do the same they will fall apart too. **So they can't be sold!** So sad to say - all the stock is bad. And the first you got to do, is stop selling them from the online page in WSO-Europe, announce on the page that they are not for sale before new prints come! And call them back if you can repair them.

Then there is they question with the ones that already have found their way to Denmark. How do we do the replacement? Do you imagine that we should gather all the books together and send it back to Brussels? That will be some job, and cost a lot of cash to do! Of course I can find out how many the areas have in stock and how many they have sold, and we can gather them together, it will just take some time to organize.

And when will there be new prints ready? Hope we can solve this in cooperation. In loving service - Mogens
